
The State of Missouri is pleased to submit the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Combined State Plan for Program Years 2016-2020. The Missouri Workforce Development Board reviewed and approved the plan at the January 14, 2016 board meeting following the close of the public comment period on January 11, 2016.

Missouri produced the combined state plan according to U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training WIOA Plan Requirements. The programs outlined in the plan are the result of a unique ongoing partnership between the Division of Workforce Development, Office of Adult Learning and Rehabilitation Services, Adult Education and Literacy Office, Division of Employment Security, Department of Social Services and the Family Support Division of the Department of Social Services.

The Missouri partners work toward continual improvement in maximizing effectiveness and efficient operations. This plan is designed with a customer-centered approach that serves Title I adult, youth and dislocated workers, Department of Education Title II adult education and family literacy programs, WIOA Title III Wagner-Peyser employment services and vocational rehabilitation programs under Title I of the Rehabilitation Act as amended by Title IV of WIOA. In addition, Missouri also includes Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Rehabilitative Services for the Blind, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Community Block Grant programs in the plan.


