Prior Experience – the maximum length of OJT shall be reduced by:

- One week (40 hours) for each month prior employment/training in same occupation with a different employer.
- 2) One week (40 hours) for each three months of prior experience using same skills in different occupation.

Prior Education – the maximum length of OJT shall be reduced by:

- 1) One week for every two semesters of prior education for the same occupation for which the OJT is written.
- 2) One week for every year (two semesters) of prior education in a related field for which the OJT is written.

*NOTE: Waivers to criteria Item #1 and #2 may be granted by OWD Director if the time of the previous work experience, the length of the previous work experience (OWD considers full time employment to be 32 hours per week) and/or training is outdated and is no longer applicable to current labor market demands. Justification for these waivers must be documented and provided to the OWD Director for approval and signature.
