METP Request for Training

Dear Sir or Madam:

Under the Missouri Employment & Training Program (METP), eligible clients may receive METP funded training. The Division of Workforce Development (DWD) uses the **METP Request for Training (DWD-PO-604)** form as the client's official request for training.

The ***Individual Certification and Training Agreement*** section of the DWD-PO-604 form must be completed by the Training Facility to provide information about a specific training program selected by the client. It provides the necessary information for a Missouri Job Center Representative to make a training determination based on the METP program regulations and operating instructions.

If the client's training request is approved by the Missouri Job Center Representative, you will be sent a copy of the **DWD-PO-604** form signed by the Job Center Rep. At that time, you will be provided instructions on how to complete the ***Trainee Termination Report*** section of the form. The ***Trainee Termination Report*** section must be completed once the client terminates from training. If the client participates in more than one training component (remedial, pre-requisite, and/or skills training), it may be necessary to complete the ***Trainee Termination Report*** section for each training component.
