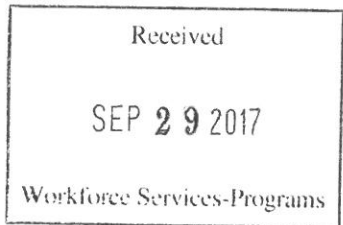

Notice of Transfer and/or Layoff

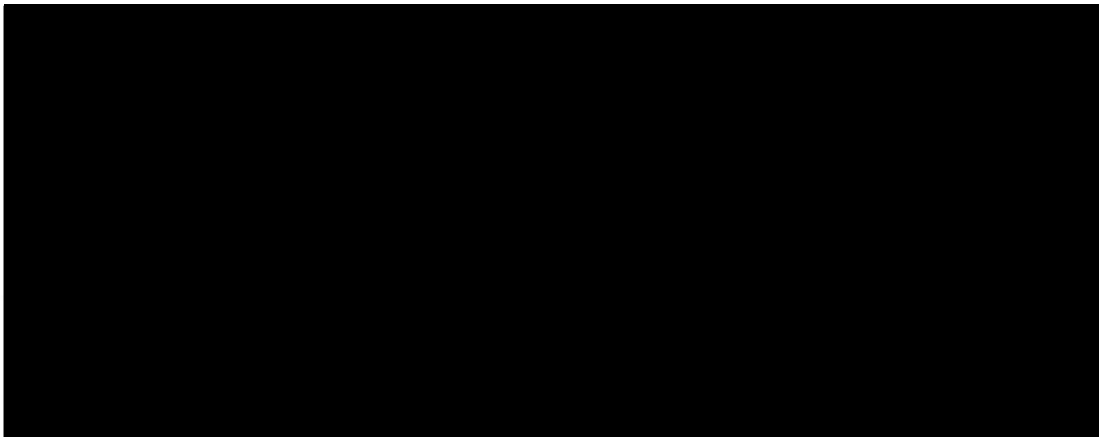
Dear Mr. Bauer:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 ("WARN"), which requires employers to give official notice to certain government units or officials of a pending mass layoff.

On or about December 1, 2017, as part of a corporate reorganization, Positronic Industries will be moving the majority of its Mt. Vernon, Missouri operation, located at 601 W. Hayward, Mt. Vernon, MO 65712, to its Springfield facilities, in an attempt to improve the operational efficiency of its manufacturing process. All departments of the Mt. Vernon operation, with the exception of the Molding operation, will be relocating to either the Eldon or Campbell Avenue facilities in Springfield, MO, with all employees being offered the opportunity to transfer. Any employees who do not accept the transfer offer will be laid off, and such layoff will be considered permanent, with no expectation of recall. Affected employees do not have bumping rights.

Job titles of positions affected, and the number of affected employees in each job classification, are as follows:

Assembly Workers: 52
Inventory/Shipping: 22
Plant Facilities: 1
Production Control: 4
Manufacturing Engineering: 6
Quality Assurance: 12
