

RETURN STRONG CHECKLIST

You may need the following documents when connecting with a Job Center:

- Drivers' license or other photo ID
- Social Security card. If you do not have a Social Security number, call the Social Security Administration at 800-772-1213 or visit [socialsecurity.gov](https://www.socialsecurity.gov)
- Additional documentation, such as your most recent check stub, proof of government benefits, and tax information may be requested for eligibility for certain services

Depending on training opportunities, you may be asked to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to see financial aid eligibility. To complete the FAFSA you will need:

- Your FSA ID (username and password) if you are submitting the FAFSA online. You can create an FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov
- If you are married, you will also need your spouse's information
- Alien Registration Number for eligible noncitizens. If you need one, visit the Citizenship and Immigration Services website at uscis.gov
- All 2018 federal income tax forms. If you did not keep copies, you can call the IRS at 800-829-1040
- All 2018 W-2 forms and, if applicable, workers' compensation benefits and Unemployment Form 1099-G. If you do not have copies, contact your employer or call the IRS at 800-829-1040
- Current cash/checking/savings account balances
- Current investment values (stocks, savings bonds, mutual funds, CDs)
- Current business value
- Current investment farm value
- 2018 child support paid or received. If you did not keep records, you can contact your local child support office or call 800-443-1576
- 2018 housing/food/living allowance for military and clergy. This information is on the Leave and Earnings Statement for military personnel and on the W-2 form for members of the clergy
- Veterans noneducation benefits. If you did not keep records, call the Department of Veterans Affairs at 800-827-1000 or visit va.gov
