

Selective Service Registration Status Self-Attestation for WIA Core Enrollments

When completing the Membership screens, all males born after 1959 will see the following message:

“All Males born after 1959 must comply with the Selective Service registration requirements in order to receive certain Career Center services. Please indicate your Selective Service registration status.”

There will be 8 selections they can choose from:

- Registered with Selective Service
- Refused to Register with Selective Service
- Active Duty Armed Forces
- Military Veteran, National Guard, or Reservist
- Cadet or Midshipman at a Service Academy
- Alien who Entered the US after the age of 25
- Hospitalized or Incarcerated from age 18 to 26
- Not registered, but would have if I knew I had to

If they chose **“Refused to Register with Selective Service”**, they are not able to proceed with the **Membership process** and will not be able to get a WIA Adult or DW Core enrollment. They will see a message that says:

“Many of our employment and training services funded by the federal government are not available to any male born after 1959 who refused to register with the Selective Service.”

Any other selection is good and they can proceed through the Membership process to a completed Core enrollment.

Staff will see a field on the Toolbox Seeker Screen, Other tab which indicates that the customer chose a selection other than “Refused to Register”, thus self-attesting to their Selective Service registration compliance.

Individuals subject to the Selective Service registration requirement that have been determined appropriate for Intensive or Training services must have their Selective Service status documented by staff at the Application and Eligibility stage, following DWD Issuance 30-2009.

In jobs.mo.gov, we added a link to the Selective Service webpage for Register and Check Registration with an explanation that reads:

“All Males born after 1959 must comply with the Selective Service registration requirements in order to receive certain Career Center services. Click here to register or check your registration.” They will see the same selections as shown above.
