

APPRENTICESHIP THROUGH TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE

This opportunity leads to a bright future for both the worker and the employer. Employers will receive a monetary incentive while equipping a potential employee with valuable skills.

WHAT IS THE TAA PROGRAM?

The TAA Program is a federal program administered by the United States Department of Labor (USDOL) that provides assistance to workers who lost their jobs due to foreign trade. A worker eligible for the TAA Program may participate in an apprenticeship.

A worker deemed eligible for the TAA Program has lost his or her job due to foreign imports coming into the United States or their job has been moved to a foreign country.

TAA FUNDING CAN BE APPLIED TOWARDS:



Work-Based Training

- TAA funds can be used to reimburse the employer for cost of training.
- Reimbursement can total up to 50 percent of participant's wage rate.



Related Training & Instruction

- TAA funds can be used to support the related instruction component of an apprenticeship program.
- Training funds can also cover supplies, books, equipment, etc.
- The length of training to be covered is dependent upon the length of the apprenticeship.
